



2023 ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET®

RULES AND REGULATIONS



NOTE: The ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET is primarily an antique auto and street rod event. We do allow some non-auto antiques & collectibles, our primary goal is to keep our event mostly automotive. The following types of items are not in keeping with this intent: telephone service sign-ups, used major appliances, chain saw statues, wood stoves, ceramics, house plants, household soaps & cleaners, used non-antique furniture or general yard sale, flea-market items (paperbacks, baby clothes, etc.).

“SCF&EC” will denote Spokane County Fair & Expo Center below.

- 1. Bicycles:** NO roller skates, skateboards, bicycles or motorized conveyances are allowed during the meet (except wheelchair type).
- 2. Cars for Sale:** These spaces are located on the north asphalt along the lawn. Cars may be on trailers, or on the ground. Car parts may NOT be sold in the special spaces for CARS FOR SALE as there may be a risk of damaging other cars close by. See the MAIN GATE SUPERVISOR to arrange for test-drives.
- 3. Deadlines:** Mailed in Vendor reservation applications & written refund requests will be accepted until June 20th post mark. Returning last year vendors wanting “same space”, or to move to a new area, the deadline is April 30th.
- 4. Dogs:** and other animals are not allowed on the SCF&EC, except for aid-assist animals. **You will be asked to remove your pet from county property.**
- 5. Electricity:** The ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET does not supply extension cords or guarantee access to electricity or utilities. A fee may be collected by the SCF&EC for utilities, if used.
- 6. Fire Safety: NO OPEN FLAMES.** All spaces are arranged with adequate fire lanes and must be kept **as they are**. Any electrical cords must be safe (no frays) and large enough for the load. Displays must meet common sense fire and safety rules.
- 7. Food Sales:** No unauthorized food, water or beverage sales. Food, water or beverage vendors are strictly permitted only by contract with SCF&EG.
- 8. Late Registration / “Gate Sales”:** Vendor Registration by mail is recommended. Unsold vendor spaces (if any are left) will be sold on a first-come first-served basis beginning Friday at 7 am. Spaces will be sold at the south vendor entrance just inside the VENDOR GATE at the SCF&EC. Do not attempt to drive into the Swap Meet during vendor set-up times if you have not registered by mail. Please park in the SOUTH parking lot and walk in the south entrance. **NO REFUNDS AFTER JUNE 1ST.**
- 9. Nails, Staples & Tape:** Do not use tape on the inside or outside of walls or windows of any SCF&EC building. Do not drive nails, tacks or staples into any interior or exterior wall of any SCF&EC building.
- 10. Parts Pickup:** For pedestrian safety and insurance purposes, motor vehicles are not allowed into the Meet during public admission. “Hire-a-kid” parts hauling will be available on the grounds. If you have a very heavy item to load, ask the Main gate supervisor for arrangements.
- 11. Refunds: Requests for refunds will not be honored after June 20th.**
- 12. Right of Refusal:** The ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET reserves the right to refuse rental of vendor space to anyone and to exclude or reject without recourse any person who has violated these rules, or is otherwise objectionable. Vendor space sales are First Come First Served.
- 13. RV Parking & Camping:** There will be no overnight camping inside the fenced area of the Swap Meet or in the Main Parking Lot. CONTACT Rachelle Buchanan at 509-477-2784 for early SCF&EC campground reservations.
- 14. Security:** The Vendor is responsible for the security of goods in their own space. Vendors must keep their spaces open for business during all public admission hours. The meet is patrolled by SCF&EC Security Officers, but it is impossible to guard every space 100%, especially if you open late or close early. Vendors must cover goods outdoors with tarps overnight.
- 15. Set-up & Parking Inside:** Vendors will be allowed to drive their vehicle into the Meet only during scheduled setup times. ALL MOTOR VEHICLES NOT IN A RENTED SPACE MUST BE MOVED TO THE OUTSIDE PARKING AREAS BEFORE THE MEET IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. If your vehicle is not properly parked, you will be asked to remove your vehicle, and/or it may be towed out of the SCF&EC area at owner's expense. Vehicles in rented spaces, must remain there during all public admission. Vendors may hand load from the parking lot at any time. No moving motor vehicles (except Security) are allowed on the SCF&EC grounds during public admission hours. The selling of parts or vehicles is not allowed in the outside parking areas or RV areas. Selling anywhere except designated Swap Meet areas is against Spokane County Ordinance.
- 16. ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET** is the registered property of ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET. Unauthorized use of “ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET” is prohibited.
- 17. Tables:** Tables are not provided. Please check local rental sources for availability of tables, racks, etc. for use at the meet.
- 18. TARPS:** No tarps will be allowed on the grass.
- 19. TAXES:** Vendors are responsible for all taxes if any.
- 20. Teardown & Move-out: (Sunday)** For pedestrian safety, no moving motor vehicles are allowed on the SCF&EC before 2 p.m. Spokane County Fire code says that the overhead doors or aisles may not be blocked. If you want to leave at other than Teardown time, or scheduled vendor access hours, you will have to hand-load to the Main parking lot. The ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET reserves the right to refuse space rental at next year's Meet to any vendor that is not open for business during all public admission hours.
- 21. Trailers:** Can remain in any inside or outside spaces, as long as the trailer does not extend outside of the rented space. Please be sure to rent enough space.
- 22. Vendor Identification:** Vendor I.D.'s are limited to two ID's per space up to a maximum of five, regardless of quantity of spaces rented. A limited number of additional vendor I.D.'s may be purchased at the south vendor entrance. You must show your receipt letter for purchase of additional vendor I.D.'s THE ALL WHEELS SWAP MEET reserves the right to limit quantity of additional vendor I.D.'s.
- 23. Vendor Vehicle Access:** Vendors driving vehicles into the Swap Meet during vendor set-up times must have a vehicle access card on the lower left (driver's side) on the dash, showing the space of the vendor. All passengers must wear vendor identification in plain sight for admittance. Vehicle cards are only valid during scheduled set-up hours. ANY VEHICLE NOT IN A RENTED SPACE MUST BE MOVED TO THE PARKING LOT BEFORE OPEN TO PUBLIC
